Completing Re-Dos/Corrections for Science

If you score a 75% (C) or below you MUST re-do the assignment. If you score a 76%-79%, it will be your choice to correct.

LABS AND OTHER WORK on paper. (Digital assignments TBD)

YOU MAY NOT ERASE YOUR ORIGINAL WORK and put your new responses in the place of the original response. I need to see the progress you are making and need the original for comparison.

- 1. Put your heading on a piece of notebook paper*. (Top left: ON the lines, not floating in the top margin; name, period, date)
- 2. Skip a line under your heading.
- 3. Begin with the number or section label on your paper.
 - a. Re-answer the question, response, or data you need to redo.
- 4. Skip a line and continue with the next question, response, or data you need to redo.
- 5. Staple the redo to the back of your original assignment.
- 6. Turn in both the original assignment and redo to the turn in box for your period.

*Sometimes your work will have space at the bottom or even on the back. We can save paper by having you re-do the work in that clean space on the original. If working on the back, PLEASE head it as listed in number one above.

SPELLING TESTS (Also TBD if digital)

- 1. Head a sheet of paper as listed above in number one above.
- 2. Write ALL words, not just the ones you missed, ten times each. (Proof that you've studied.)
- 3. Head a second piece of paper as listed in number one in the first section above.
- 4. Have an adult, (parent, teacher etc.) give you your spelling retest.
- 5. Have the adult sign the retest.
- 6. **Staple** the **retest** to **TOP** of your **corrections/practice**. (The page that you wrote your words ten times each)
- 7. Turn them in.
